Despite the isolation Covid-19 brought with it, we did learn how to work with Zoom and other virtual platforms. On-line courses and classes became more accessible and I hope you have been taking advantage of all that is offered through EGA, SCR and other stitching outlets.

I look forward to getting under way, and with your support and participation it promises to be an interesting and fun undertaking. Here is what we have planned so far:

In the program section during our general meetings held on the 4th Tuesday of every month we will highlight various aspects of stitching both for the seasoned stitchers as well as the newcomers amongst us. Your input is greatly appreciated either with topic suggestions or a presentation.

Three-hour technique classes will be offered on the 2nd Saturday in February, April, September, and November. In February we will explore a technique that is simple, yet effective (see write-up under Technique Classes in this newsletter). From April 2021 until November 2022, we will be offering a series of 6 classes teaching several different techniques, pulling them all together into a final project during our 7th and final class. So please join us whenever you can. Look forward to seeing you!

"What is this Chicken Scratch?"



I hear that all the time from my kids when I write them a note in cursive. But illegible notes are not what we shall talk about at our January meeting. Instead, this is a different kind of "Chicken Scratch" – an embroidered one. You might have heard about this type of embroidery: it is a way to effectively take a simple Gingham and give it a lacey look. Intrigued? Join us during our meeting to learn about its history. Then join us during our February Technique Class to learn how to do it. You will find information to sign up in the *Technique Classes* section.

Hooped, Stretched or Snapped

Walking into an embroidery store can be overwhelming, especially if you have not done a lot of stitching before. The plethora of threads, fabrics, scissors, needles, and other paraphernalia is dizzying. Once you have decided on your project though, you must now select a way to ready it for stitching. Do you use a hoop, stretcher bars, Q-snaps? During the February meeting we will explore the ways to frame your piece for stitching and which method is best to use for the kind of embroidery you are doing.

Stitch-Ins

Using cross stitch, double cross stitch, running, straight and woven stitches create a lacey effect to transform ordinary Gingham into something elegant. This is an excellent project for beginners as the method is simple and the results are beautiful.

Select a kit from three different colors. All you need are your regular stitching supplies.




